

AGREEMENT TO RECEIVE PERIODIC STATEMENTS ELECTRONICALLY

This disclosure governs, along with any other documents applicable to this account including the Credit Union's Electronic Funds Transfer Agreement and Membership Account Agreement, the agreement between the member and Credit Union regarding receiving periodic statements electronically. The member acknowledges that a printed periodic statement will no longer be mailed to the member. If, at any time, the member decides that he/she no longer wants to receive the periodic statement(s) electronically and wants to resume receiving a printed copy of the periodic statement, the member must log into home banking at www.doifcu.org, click on "secure forms", click on "secure email form" and enter "Discontinue E-Statements" in the subject line, click "Submit" or send a letter to the credit union stating your account number and that you wish to discontinue receive e-statements for such action to be taken. The address is 1849 C Street NW room 4045, Washington DC 20240. It is understood that any actions that are to be taken by the Credit Union under this Agreement will not be taken until the Credit Union has had a reasonable opportunity to act upon such actions. This agreement does not include receiving Visa credit card statements electronically. If you are receiving an electronic copy of your statement and need the credit union to send you a paper copy you will be charged a fee in accordance with our current fee disclosure.

Consent To Receive Other Account-related Information We often include with your paper account statement other periodic notices. For short, we refer to these as "statement inserts." When you consent to electronic delivery of your account statements, you will also be consenting to electronic delivery of statement inserts.

The periodic statement(s) will be available through the Online Account Access system via the Internet. An electronic mail (e-mail) notification will be sent to the address shown below when the statement(s) are available for viewing. The member who receives this e-mail is the agent for his/her joint owners for the purpose of receiving and notifying them that the statement(s) is available. The member must notify the Credit Union within 30-days after receiving the e-mail notification of any discrepancies. If the member fails to notify the Credit Union, the member will have no claim against the Credit Union. However, if the discrepancy is the result of an electronic funds transfer, the provisions of the Credit Union's Electronic Funds Transfer Agreement will control this resolution. If the undersigned does not receive a statement(s) from the Credit Union because he/she failed to supply the Credit Union with a correct e-mail address, the Credit Union will stop sending electronic statements and return to sending paper statements until the undersigned specifically makes a written request that the Credit Union resume sending the electronic statements and a proper e-mail address has been supplied to the Credit Union. The member agrees that the Credit Union is not liable to the member if the member is unable to access the e-mail site or download the statement to a printer.

I understand that my periodic statement(s) will no longer be sent to me by U.S. Mail and that I will need access to the Online Account system via the Internet, an e-mail account and Adobe Acrobat reader software version 5.0 or later in order to have access to my statement electronically. (Adobe Acrobat reader software is available to download from Adobe's web site at <https://www.adobe.com/products/acrobat/readstep2.html> free of charge. Electronic statements will be retained by us for 12 months starting with the July 2007 statement information. If you need a copy, you may print your statement using the print function of your internet browser or store your electronic statements on your hard drive for later retrieval.
